August 9, 10, 11	<p>Senior Portraits - Sign up for a Session B portrait session!</p> <p>JMHS is using Victor O'Neill Studios again this year. Our third and last session date is currently being scheduled for late October/early November. You will receive another announcement from the school when the next session is available for booking. The attire for the yearbook photo will be in the traditional Tuxedos and Drapes. We will provide the Tuxedo and Drapes. In addition to the yearbook session, we also offer sessions that include casual/personality portraits and cap and gown portraits. If you have any questions, email seniors@vosphoto.com. Students will enter door 9 (in the back of the building by the Wrestling room / Warhawk Hall) and proceed to Warhawk Hall.</p>
August 10, 11, 14	<p>Parking Permit Pick Up for Seniors</p> <p>Seniors (and their parents) who requested a parking pass through the Senior Parking Request form will receive an email detailing how to pay for their parking pass and next steps. The application form for seniors closes August 4th. Seniors may pick up their pass from 12 - 2 p.m. each of these days at Door 11. They must have proof of payment through MySchoolBucks (printed or emailed receipt or screen shot) and an ID to pick up their parking pass. The actual parking passes will be issued first come, first served. Students may not request specific spots but when they arrive to pick up their pass, they may request a spot in a specific lot as long as there are spots left in that lot.</p>
August 15, 16	<p>Parking Permit Pick Up for Juniors</p> <p>The application form for Juniors closes August 11. Once the form has closed, juniors (and their parents) who requested a parking pass through the Junior Parking Request form will receive an email notifying them if they have been selected through the randomized lottery to get a parking pass or if they've been placed on the waiting list. For those receiving a parking pass, the email will also include payment information and next steps in the process. Selected juniors may pick up their pass from 12:00-2:00 p.m. on these days at Door 11. They must have proof of payment through MySchoolBucks (printed or emailed receipt or screen shot) and an ID to pick up their parking pass. The parking passes will be in either the junior lot or in the gravel lot.</p>
August 16	<p>6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. - Flight School Parent Program</p> <p>The JMHS School Counseling Department will introduce freshmen parents to Madison High School and what to expect freshman year. This event will take place in the Auditorium.</p>

<p>August 17</p>	<p>6:00 a.m. - Student Schedules go live in StudentVUE Student Schedules go live in StudentVUE. All students will be able to see their class schedule in StudentVUE and 9th and 10th graders will also see their locker number and combination. Juniors and seniors who would like to request a locker may do so by completing this request form, and they will be assigned lockers the first week of school. Students log in using their FCPS username and password.</p> <p>9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. - New Student Orientation This is for any new students (grades 10-12) to become better acquainted with the building and learn what to expect entering Madison this school year. A general overview will be presented, and student leaders will be available to answer questions and provide new students a tour of the building. New students should enter through the Main Entrance - Door 1.</p> <p>1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. - Freshman Flight School (Orientation) - Auditorium This is an opportunity for the entire freshman class to receive information to help students get prepared for their transition to high school. All freshmen should attend even if they participated in the Madison Bridges program as they will be paired with their upperclassmen mentor for the first time. A variety of lessons and important information will be shared by our student mentors during the program. No registration is needed.</p> <p>3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. - Student Open House This is an opportunity for students to walk through the building and meet their teachers.
